When deployed with Microsoft® Office SharePoint® Server 2007, Microsoft Dynamics GP can transform people's ability to access and analyze accurate, updated data in a format that makes sense, whether they work in Microsoft Dynamics GP or another application such as Microsoft Office Excel®, which has report templates based on more than 200 SmartList favorites.
